Maple: a light colored hardwood, Maple has a close, fine, uniform texture that is generally straight-grained. This is a very durable hardwood and will take any color stain or paint well.



Oak: has a reddish cast and is a very hard wood with a mostly straight open grain. This is an extremely durable, great wear-resistance hardwood that stains well to a beautiful finish.



Cherry: has beautiful reddish brown to deep red color with lighter streaks of sapwood. Cherry has a fine uniform, straight grain, satiny smooth texture, the beauty of this hardwood and accompanying even grain has been a favorite choice of customers for centuries.

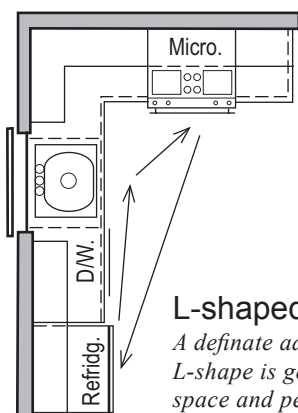
U-shaped

If you could use more space consider a U-shape. It is perfect for one or more cooks.



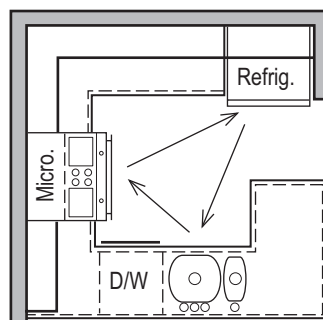
Galley

A galley is an efficient workspace for a single cook.



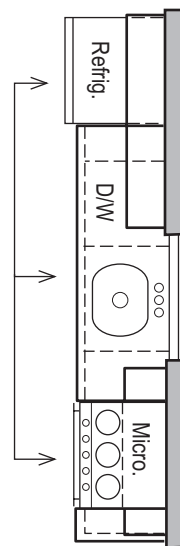
L-shaped

Single Wall

A single wall layout is a necessity in smaller homes and apartments where space is limited.

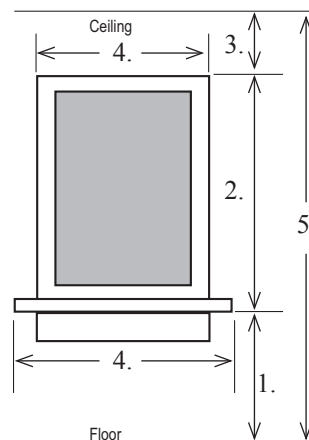
- Make a sketch of your room; mark all doors, windows, electrical outlets and permanent fixtures.
- Measure in inches not feet.
- Measure openings: doors and windows from the outside trim edge.
- Indicate which way the doors swing. 
- Once you have accurate measurements transfer it to grid paper.

Walls

1. Measure the full length of the wall from the left corner out.
2. Measure segments: From the left measure to the outer edge of the first opening (*door or window*).
3. Measure across the opening from outside trim edge to outside trim edge.
4. Measure from the outside trim edge of that opening to the next opening or the end of the wall.

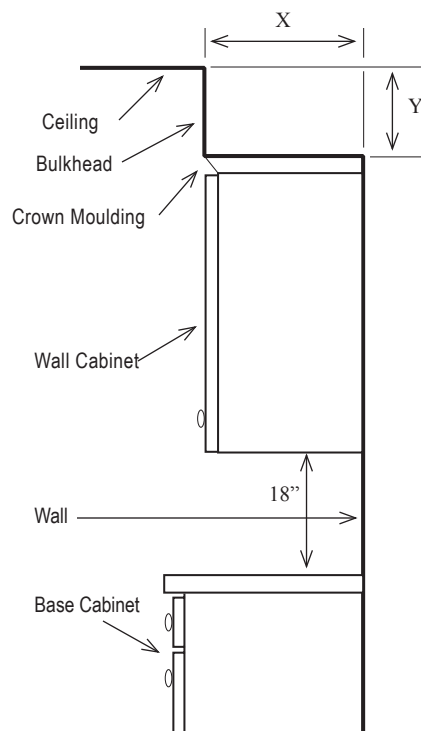
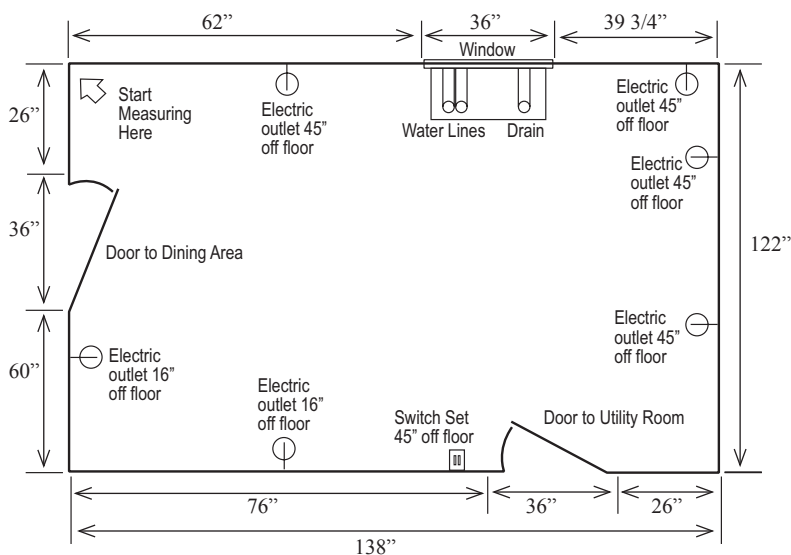
Windows:

1. Measure from floor to window sill.
2. Measure from window sill to top of window.
3. Measure from top of the window to ceiling
4. Measure the width of the window.

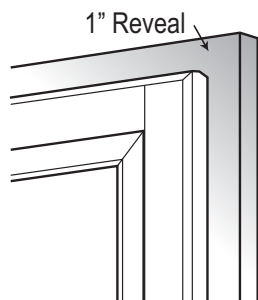

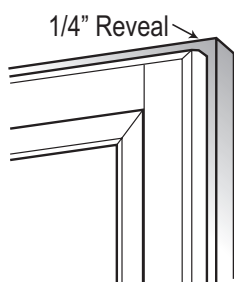
1. Make a list of all kitchen appliances
2. Measure the width, height and depth of all relevant appliances.
3. Measure construction details such as bulkheads, crown mouldings etc.

Note: Cabinet face frame rails and stiles are 1 1/2" wide.

Cope and stick construction: the joints are machined to interlock with a tongue and groove, glued, clamped and pin nailed during assembly.

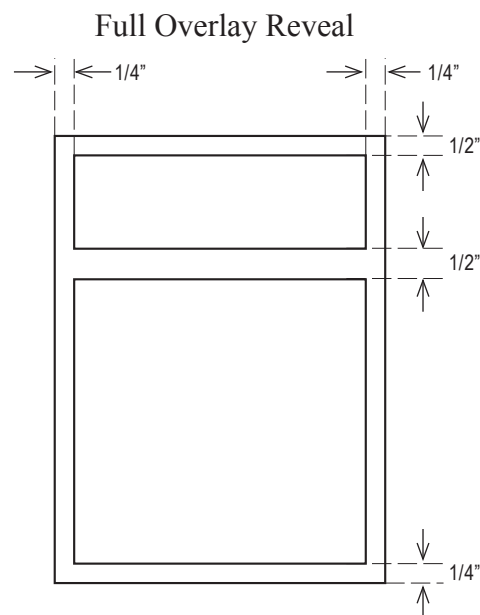
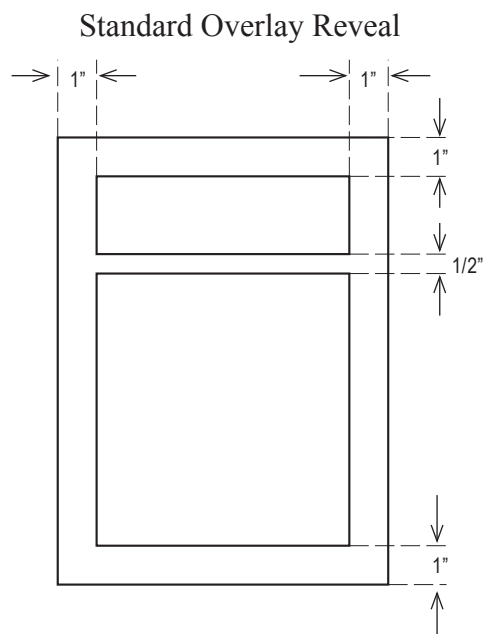
Mitered door construction: has a 45 degree angle joint that is glued, clamped and secured with metal fasteners.

The panels are floating panels held in place with rubber spacing balls to absorb any expansion and contraction and keep the panel in place. All of our raised panels and frames are solid wood; flat panels are plywood.

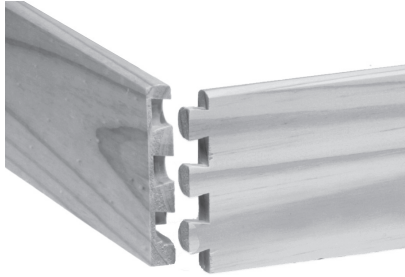

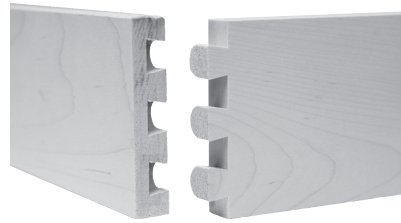
Drawer Construction

The drawer boxes are English dovetailed on all four corners, 1/4" plywood bottom panel is glued in place and blind nailed to create a strong square drawer box that will endure the test of time.

Drawer face is attached to the front of the box using four panhead screws.

- Standard wall cabinets come in 12", 15", 18", 21", 24", 27", 30", 36" and 42" heights with a 12" or 15" depth.
- 12" 15" and 18" high wall cabinets have no interior shelves
- 21", 24", and 27" high wall cabinets have one adjustable shelf.
- 30" and 36" high cabinets have two adjustable shelves.
- 42" high cabinets have three adjustable shelves.
- Max. height for wall cabinets: 48"
- Smallest door size for Cathedral/ Arch doors is 9" w X 12" h
- Cabinets less than 12" wide have a solid door (raised, flat panel, cathedral and arch not available).

Vanity Cabinets

- Standard vanities are 31" high and 21" deep, have false drawer fronts, bottom shelf. Tall vanities are 34 1/2" high.
- Narrow vanities are 31" or 34 1/2" high and 18" deep, have false drawer fronts, one bottom shelf.

Ordering Wall Cabinets

The first letters of cabinet model numbers refer to the group of cabinet-type ("W" for wall).

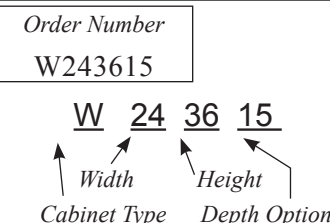
- The numbers after the letters refer to the width of the cabinet. In the example below, the "24" indicates that the actual width of the cabinet is 24".

- The second set of numbers refers to the cabinet height. In the example, the "36" indicates that the actual height of the cabinet is 36 inches.

- If the cabinet has a non-standard depth (*standard depth is 12"*), the next two digits reflect the depth. In the example, the "15" indicates that the actual depth of the cabinet is 15 inches. If a cabinet is the standard 12" depth, this number is not required.

- The letter following the height or the depth option is used for the wood species. "M" is the letter code for Maple, "K" is the letter code for Oak, "C" is the letter code for Cherry.

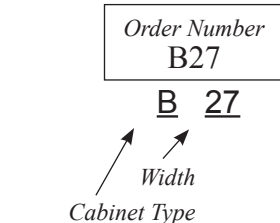
